INTRODUCTION

Généralités En 1866 brûlait la cure du Sépey aux Ormonts, et avec elle la majeure partie des registres paroissiaux dès 1578. Fort heureusement, DAVID TARDENT (1737-1827) qui fut instituteur à Vevey, avait, en 1815, relevé de ces registres tout ce qui intéressait notre famille. Ces notes, son petit-fils LOUIS VINCENT SAMUEL (1787-1836) les prit avec lui lors de son émigration à Chabag en Bessarabie en 1822. C'est là que HENRI ALEXIS TARDENT (1853-1929) les trouva lors de sa visite à la colonie en 1872. Dans son ouvrage intitulé " Notices historiques et biographiques sur la famille Tardent", dont le manuscrit est déposé aux Archives cantonales vaudoises à Lausanne, et que nous appellerons par la suite tout simplement l' "Historique", l'auteur dit que ces notes, complétées de détails fournis par les branches russe et belge de notre famille, de volumineuses correspondances, d'antiques actes de partage et autres, lui permirent de rédiger cet Historique en 1887, année de son émigration en Australie.

En outre, au début de notre siècle, l'Etat de Vaud chargea FRANÇOIS ISABEL, instituteur à Antagne sur Ollon, connu pour ses études sur le district d'Aigle, de procéder aux recherches nécessaires à la reconstitution des documents d'état civil disparus dans l'incendie. C'est à l'aide de minutes de notaires, d'inscriptions au cadastre, d'entretiens avec de vieilles personnes et d'autres sources, que ce précieux chercheur parvint à déposer aux Archives cantonales une documentation très utile.

Pour pouvoir dresser ce tableau, il a fallu procéder à de longues et laborieuses recherches. Ainsi JULES TARDENT-HORN (1894) en Australie, fils de HENRI ALEXIS cité plus haut, parcourut le continent australien pour y retrouver les descendants de son père et de son oncle MARC ALEXIS TARDENT (1860-1928) émigré, lui, en 1891. De son côté, HELENE TARDENT-MASSET (1901) à Lausanne, fouilla aux Archives cantonales registres, terriers et autres documents jusqu'au 16ème siècle. Les Autorités d'Ormont-Dessous fournirent de nombreux extraits d'état civil. Diverses paroisses du canton de Fribourg donnèrent des renseignements sur la branche devenue fribourgeoise, et qui a conservé l'orthographe TARDIN jusqu'à ce jour (page FR 47). Enfin quelques descendants de la colonie suisse de Chabag et de celui de la branche belge, contribuèrent à l'édification de cet inventaire généalogique. Que chacun soit remercié de sa collaboration.

Origine

Nous ne possédons aucune précision quant à notre origine. Un terrain situé au sud du Sépey est mentionné en 1398 sous le nom de SERTARDENT (de "essert", qui signifie lieu défriché); aujourd'hui il est appelé SCEX TARDENT, ce qui est une altération de la forme aphéritique de SERTARDENT.

Ceci permet d'affirmer que de nos ancêtres habitaient les Ormonts au 14ème siècle. D'où venaient-ils?

Selon l'Historique, une tradition orale dans la branche belge veut que nous soyons originaires de Neuchâtel en Normandie. Afin d'apporter quelque lumière sur cette question, nous nous sommes adressés aux autorités des communes suivantes: Neufchâtel-sur-Aisne (Aisne), Neufchâtel-en-Bray (Seine maritime), Neufchâtel-Hardelot (Pas-de-Calais), Neufchâtel-en-Saônois (Sarthe), Neufchâtel-Urtière (Doubs) et enfin Neuchâtel (Doubs). De partout les réponses furent négatives. Il n'y a pas d'autres Neufchâtel ou Neuchâtel en France

Une autre version est celle qui voudrait savoir les TARDENT originaires du Tardenois en Champagne. Qu'en penser? Nous rejoignons alors le Neufchâtel-sur-Aisne cité plus haut.

Au cours de nos recherches nous ^{avons} pris contact avec des TARDAN originaires des Pyrénées. Ce fut d'abord ARNAUD TARDAN à Paris, puis JEAN TARDAN à Mexico. Les deux nous renvoyèrent aux maires de quelques communes telles qu'Arudy, Lescar, Tardets. Les renseignements reçus ne permettent pas ou pas encore, de déceler une origine commune avec celle des Suisses. Peut-être que de futurs chercheurs y parviendront.

Reste la possibilité d'une origine savoyarde, comme le dit l'Historique, origine qui serait celle de la plupart des familles des Ormonts. Sous le vocable Savoie, il faut entendre également le Chablais. Or l'Académie chablaisienne à Thonon ne veut ^{rien} savoir d'un patronyme TARDENT.

En conclusion et faute de preuves historiques, force nous est de laisser ouverte la question de notre origine.

Orthographie

Au cours des siècles, notre nom, comme beaucoup d'autres, fut orthographié de différentes façons. Nous trouvons TARDENT, TARDEM, TARDENS, TARDAIN, TARDAINT, TARDET, TARDIN, TERDENT, TREDEN, THARDENT. Pour des raisons de phonétique, les branches russe et bessarabienne s'appelaient occasionnellement TARDAN. Il en va de même des noms géographiques tels que CERGNAT, CERNIAT, SERNIAT, SERNYA, MELLEYS, MELY, MELI, et nous en passons.

Il s'agit partiellement d'écritures phonétiques de prononciations patoises.

Chabag

Ce nom évoque, à qui s'intéresse à l'histoire des TARDENT, toute une aventure vécue par plusieurs générations. On ne peut, dans le cadre de cette introduction, n'en donner qu'un aperçu.

En 1821, le tsar Alexandre Ier de Russie, intervient auprès de son ancien précepteur, le Vaudois Frédéric César de la Harpe, afin qu'il engage quelques uns de ses compatriotes à venir restaurer et développer les vignes de la Bessarabie, province que le Traité de Bucarest de 1812 rattacha à la Russie à la suite de sa victoire sur les Turcs. Des agriculteurs-vignerons de la région lémanique s'intéressèrent à la chose.

L'un d'eux, LOUIS VINCENT SAMUEL TARDENT (1787-1820) fut délégué pour aller sur place discuter des modalités d'une immigration. Les conditions sont bonnes: les colons seraient exonérés d'impôts et de service militaire pendant dix années, auraient la liberté de parler leur langue, de pratiquer leur religion et d'avoir leur école. Chaque colon recevrait gratuitement 60 déciatines de terres (environ 65 hectares), jouirait de la liberté de commerce et devrait prêter serment de fidélité à la Couronne.

TARDENT revint faire rapport. En octobre 1822 huit familles romandes émigrent. Le mouvement continue jusqu'en 1831. Le nombre de colons fixé dès le début n'ayant pas été atteint, le Gouvernement russe fit appel à des familles suisses alémaniques et allemandes. La colonie était organisée civiquement, avait son pasteur et son instituteur venus de Suisse; on était en relations sporadiques avec la mère-patrie, on restait de préférence citoyen suisse. La région, située sur la rive droite du Liman du Dniester, au bord de la Mer Noire, est fertile. Les bonnes récoltes alternaient avec d'autres. Tout alla tant bien que mal jusqu'à la guerre de 1914-1918. En 1918, la Bessarabie est occupée par les armées roumaines, ce qui la préserve de la révolution et de ses misères. En 1940, Hitler fit cadeau de la province aux Russes qui l'occupèrent à nouveau le 28 juin 1940. Cette annexion fut l'arrêt de mort de la colonie. Certains colons purent fuir à temps et venir en Suisse; d'autres furent engagés de force dans l'armée russe; on ne sait ce qu'ils sont devenus.

En 1892, un groupe de colons de Chabag s'en va fonder sur les bords du Dnieper, près de Kherson, une nouvelle colonie qu'ils appellent "Osnova", et en 1909, d'autres fondent dans la même région le "Nouveau Chabag". Tout laissait présager un succès, mais la guerre et la Révolution russe anéantirent les plus belles promesses. Ce fut la ruine.

Personnages On ne sait que peu de chose de nos ancêtres aux Ormonts. Certains furent châtelains. Il faut entendre par là une fonction publique qui correspond quelque peu à celle de nos préfets d'aujourd'hui. Il est certain que plusieurs d'entre eux furent de gros propriétaires terriens. Parmi ceux d'une époque plus récente, il en est qui, soit par leur intelligence, leur courage ou leur esprit d'aventure, font figures de proie. Si nous en parlons c'est que des documents qui les concernent sont passés à la postérité.

Prenons d'abord DAVID (1737-1820) (voir AT 9.111) Il ouvre en 1760 une école au Sépey, où il introduit de nouvelles méthodes d'enseignement; il se met à dos les autorités qui craignent en lui un révolutionnaire. En 1766 il est régent, lisez instituteur, à Chernes sur Montreux. Enfin, dès 1771, il tient classe à Vevey, et ceci pendant 44 ans, tout en prenant part active à la vie de l'Eglise. Il a publié plusieurs ouvrages élémentaires de pédagogie, dont une "Histoire de l'Helvétie" et une "Grammaire abrégée pour apprendre l'orthographe sans savoir le latin".

Son petit-fils LOUIS VINCENT SAMUEL (1787-1836) (voir AT 11.82) est le fondateur de la colonie suisse de Chabag en Bessarabie. Voir ci-dessous sous Chabag.

AUGUSTE HENRI (1848-1909) (voir AT 13.22) quitte la maison paternelle très tôt, et travaille dans l'agriculture dans le Canton de Vaud. En 1869, à Genève, il fait la connaissance fortuite d'une personnalité russe qui l'encourage à émigrer en Russie. Il le fera. Il passe quelques mois en Allemagne, arrive à St-Pétersbourg, alors capitale de la Russie. Tour à tour répétiteur dans des pensionnats, liquoriste, comptable, marchand de vins, on le trouve à Nijni-Novgorod, Moscou, Odessa et ailleurs. En 1876, les menaces de guerre contre la Turquie l'engagent à se mettre au service de la Croix-Rouge. Dès lors il passe d'un champ de bataille à l'autre, organisant le transport des blessés, pour lequel il a développé différents types de chariots. Pendant plusieurs années il est le collaborateur immédiat du général Balatchof, délégué en chef de la Croix-Rouge russe. Il l'accompagne en Chine. Pendant la guerre russo-japonnaise de 1904-1905, il ne quitte pas Port-Arthur où le retiennent ses obligations humanitaires. Entre les campagnes il s'occupe de son école particulière d'Eriwan au Caucase, dans laquelle enseigne également sa femme Véra.

HENRI ALEXIS (1853-1929) (voir AT 13.23) Comme son frère AUGUSTE il s'expatrie encore très jeune. Il passe deux ans en Galicie en qualité de précepteur, en profite pour étudier le polonais et l'allemand, va en Podolie (Ukraine). Apprenant fortuitement l'existence de la colonie suisse de Chabag, il s'y rend. Il y fait la connaissance de celle qui deviendra sa femme, HORTENSE TARDET (1857-1932) (voir AT 13.86) petite-fille du fondateur de la colonie. Il est répétiteur dans un gymnase à Odessa, puis précepteur à Tiraspol, travaille le russe et le latin, passe à Nicolaief dans un gymnase. Pendant douze ans il est dans l'enseignement, ce qui lui vaut le titre de Conseiller d'Etat. En 1887 il émigre en Australie avec quatre enfants. Il fonde le journal "The Democrat", s'essaie à la littérature, fait le commerce de vins*, tente à la politique, fonde et dirige les deux premières stations d'essais agricoles du Queensland.

* en association avec son frère MARC ALEXIS (1860-1928) (voir AT 13.24) qui l'a rejoint en Australie en 1891.

Enfin citons encore CHARLES RODOLPHE ADRIEN (1812-1856) (voir AT 12.102), fils du fondateur de Chabag. Il y arriva âgé de neuf ans, s'intéressa aux sciences naturelles, devint un oenologue de renom par la publication d'un ouvrage sur la viticulture et l'oenologie. Une troisième édition de cet ouvrage sortit en 1874, soit dix-huit ans après le décès de l'auteur.

Propriétés

A titre de curiosité, nous avons relevé quelques inscriptions dans les terriers. Elle concernent des acquisitions, des ventes ou des héritages de terres par un ou une TARDET. Ces textes sont intéressants par leur tournure, les mesures de surface, et tout particulièrement par les noms géographiques locaux de l'époque, noms qui, pour la plupart, ont disparu.

On saura que:

pasquier désigne un pâturage

raspe se dit d'un terrain de peu de valeur

seyteur ou seytorée ou seyturée représente la surface qu'un homme peut faucher d'un matin quarte de terre est probablement le quart d'un seyteur.

Entre parenthèses, les numéros d'ordre de la personne dans notre Inventaire.

JACQUEMOZ TARDENS de la Mosse (JA 4.2) a eu de sa femme Claudaz Jacquerod le 15.9.1565 une pose et demie de bois, terre, pré, au Trestorrent, lieu dit au pomey. Quatre seyturées de prés et pasquiers à la Planaz Joux, autrement dit "en Chauvaiget".

Au pasquier commun du Larsey, a la Combaz, une pose de terre et une demi^e de seyturée de prés, sise à la Mosse. Encore à la Planaz Joux: neuf seyturées de pré et sept seyturées de pasquiers en bordure de la charrière publique. Au pasquier de la Frassettaz, quatre seyturées, au territoire du Draday (Vouettes) trois seyturées et demi de pré avec grange dessus.

PIERRE, fils du précédent, mari de Pernette Chablaix (JA 5.1) le 15.9.1565, de sa femme: demi pose de terre et dix seyturées en bois et pasquiers à la Combaz. A acheté au Trestorrent une quarte de terre. Au territoire de les Stinies, deux seyturées de prés et de raspes. Pernette a eu au Coudray, demi pose de terre et trois seyturées de bois et de raspe avec une grange dessus au Morel, un "morselz" de pré aux Vouettes (Planard), un "Chesaulx" de grenyer aux Sernyes. Trois seyturées de prés tant bonnes que stériles sises au territoire des Vouettes avec les maisonnements dessus existants. Au Coudray une quarte de terre avec un seytEUR et demi de pasquier ou de bois. A la montagne de Sonnaz, PERNETTE est reconnue "comparsonnière" avec Nantermoz Ogguey.

MERMET (JJ 5.105) de la Comballaz et des Champs, par sa femme Marie Burtin; le 4 octobre 1565, a acheté à Planaz Joux un seytEUR de pré. A eu de sa femme onze seyturées de pasquiers aux Champs. En indivi, une pose de terre, deux seyturées de prés et les maisonnements dessus existants, avec Claude Herdryon autrement Monney, François Rolyer de la Combaz Jean Burtin. Au Jochet trois seyturées de prés.

CLAUDE (6.23) de feu LOUIS TARDENT de JEAN le 8.9.1565, hérite avec ses frères LOUYS et PIERRE et JEAN de biens au Vernay soit en Chesaulx Mugnier et au Puys. Il a reconnu à sa femme Claudaz Mottier des biens en Ouzon, en Carrettaz, aux Siernes.

Conclusion
JEAN (JJ 2.4) de Sernyat (date ?) a eu avec son frère GUILLAUME 1^oune maison et grange en la ville de Sernyat jouxte les possessions de divers TARDET (Robert et feu Jean). 2^o en laz Toneyre. 3^o au Ruart. 4^o En Rovynaz en la preysaz. 5^o En Chavallet. 6^o En la Preysaz. 7^o En Oudon à la Palaz. 8^oEn les Combes autrement en Ramel. 9^o En Badouse, au Lavanchie. 10^o En les communs des Chables, lieu dit es cornes du Chavalet. 11^o des biens "que solayent" (soient!)être de feu CLAUDE TARDET en la montagne des Charbonnyeres.

PIERRE TARDET des Moilles (JJ 4.60?), le 4 août 1565, en indivis avec MICHEL de MICHEL TARDET et CLAUDE d'ANTOINE, d'une pièce au territoire de la Rovinaz, au Croz en la Presaz.

PIERRE et ses soeurs (JJ 4.60/4.61) (date?) héritent de terrains au territoire des Combes d'ouzon, dessus loz siez de la Tryau, et du Lavanchier en Badouze.

CLAUDE TARDET (MT 3.10) de VUILLEMET (date?) avait des terres au Verney, héritées de tous temps, au Chesallet, à la Frasse, sur le Fey, à la Leschière, au bey du Cerfz.

GRAND CLAUDE (JJ 3.60) le 4.9.1565 hérite de son père Amey au pied de Sernyat, en la Combaz, en Fontannaz, en Lessert, à la Barma, en la Frasse, en Ouzon, en Fracherel en emodioux, en Villiodaz.

CLAUDE (AT 4.2) de CLAUDE d'ANTOINE a hérité de son père au pied de Sernyat, au lieu dit en Lexert, en la Chintryaz, en la Palaz, en Longchampt, en la Frasse, au Crestallet, aux Granges, en Chabloz.

CLAUDAZ (MT 4.21) de feu MERMET TARDENT a des biens en Cretaz (8.9.1565)

CLAUDAZ (JJ 4.80) de feu CLAUDE (5.9.1565) hérite des biens venant de feu ROBERT de feu JEAN, au lieu dit Laz Palaz, de feu CLAUDE d'ANTOINE T. en la Combaz.

Sa soeur FRANCOISE (JJ 4.81) femme de JEHAN de feu Antoine Dupertuis et son neveu CLAUDE (JJ 5.106) de PIERRE, des biens au Verney. CLAUDAZ a hérité de la Combaz.

CLAUDE TARDENT (JJ 5.106) des Melleys (date?) a reçu ou acquis des biens venant de MICHEL fils de CLAUDE au pré du Vua en Rouvenaz, ou de ROBERT de feu JEAN aux Melleys.....au Cerfz lieu dit planyt

Branches

Conclusion Les auteurs de cet inventaire sont conscients de l'imperfection de leur travail, particulièrement
pour ce qui concerne l'époque des siècles passés. Cependant les recouplements opérés avec les ren-
seignements sur les alliances avec d'autres familles de la région laissent espérer un minimum
de lacunes.

Outre la patience des chercheurs, sachons admirer l'institution de l'état civil, des cadastres
et des archives de notre société. Sans ces sources de renseignements il eût été impossible de
mener à chef cet inventaire généalogique d'une famille de montagnards que ni fortune ni titre
de noblesse ne prédestinaient à aucune célébrité.
